

# SALT DOUGH ORNAMENTS

Easy DIY for kids and families

## **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1/2 1 cup warm water

# **EQUIPMENT**

- Cookie cutters
- Straw
- Ribbon
- Paint and glitter, to decorate

### **TIPS**

- If you have time, let your ornaments air dry for a day before baking them. This helps prevent them from puffing up.
- You can decorate your ornaments after they're baked with paint and glitter

#### **METHOD**

- Combine flour and salt in a bowl then slowly add the warm water until it forms a dough.
- 2 Knead the dough on a lightly floured surface until it's soft and non-sticky (add a little more flour if it's too sticky and a little more water if it's too crumbly).
- Roll the dough until it's about 1-2cm thick then use cookie cutters or hand print.
- Place shapes on a lined baking tray, then use a straw to make a hole to thread the ribbon through.
- Dry in the oven on a very low heat (approx. 100°C) for 2-3 hours. Flip over and bake on the other side.
